Petitioner is one of the 25 persons having assaulted the complainant and his brother-in-law. Challan has already been presented. He has been in custody w.e.f. 11.10.2014. The trial is likely to take a long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court subject to the condition that before releasing the petitioner, the petitioner would be required to furnish an undertaking that he will not indulge in the same activity during the pendency of the trial and will not make an attempt to threaten or browbeat the witnesses or hamper the trial in any manner. In case of any such eventuality, it will be open to the prosecution agency/complainant to seek cancellation of bail to the petitioner.
