Petitioner has been in custody w.e.f.15.04.2014 in a case registered at the instance of Suresh Kumar alleging that his sister Neelam who was married to petitioner on 17.03.2013 was harassed and beaten up to such an extent for not bringing sufficient dowry that she was found dead with strangulation mark on the neck.

Without expression of any opinion on merits, it is sufficient to observe here that out of 19 witnesses of the prosecution, 18 have already been examined.

In view of the status of the trial, no ground is made out for grant of bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed expecting that trial would be concluded expeditiously by the trial Court.
