By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.748, dated 04.10.2013, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 506, 363 and 365 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner is not the beneficiary. To show her *bona fide*, the petitioner had already deposited the alleged embezzled amount with District Social Welfare Office. In pursuance of the order dated 05.01.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 05.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
