Petitioners, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seek quashing of FIR No.211 dated 07.12.2004 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala, on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion was issued.

It is undisputed between the parties that after acquittal of the petitioners, two appeals were filed, one appeal was filed by the State and another appeal was filed by the complainant-Raghbir Singh, claiming himself to be the victim. During the pendency of the appeal, parties arrived at an amicable settlement and based on the said compromise, Raghbir Singh withdrew his appeal vide order dated 27.05.2015 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the learned Appellate Court in the appeal which has been filed by the State against them, against the judgment of acquittal, which is pending for 23.09.2015, by moving an appropriate application on the basis of compromise.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
