On 24.12.2014, an order was passed by this Court that the parties would appear before the trial Court and the trial Court would record the statements of the parties concerned and also report about the genuineness and validity or otherwise of the compromise. From order dated 12.2.2015, it is clear that statements of the parties have not been recorded as they did not appear before the trial Court and, therefore, the matter was adjourned to 12.3.2015 to enable the parties to get their statements recorded.

However, the case was not taken up on 12.3.2015 and it was adjourned for today. Still the parties did not appear before the trial Court. It appears that the compromise has either fizzled out or whatsoever reason, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the petition.
