Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking appropriate direction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, fairly states that before approaching this Court, though petitioner has approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.1 many a times but he did not retain a copy of representation. He further submits that given an opportunity, petitioner shall move an appropriate representation in writing to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.1 within a period of one week from today and he may be directed to consider and decide the same within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.1 is directed that if the petitioner approaches him by moving an appropriate representation within a period of one week from today, he shall consider and decide the same at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of representation from the petitioner.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
