1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 & 5.

At the very outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners states that the age of the petitioner No.2-boy has wrongly been mentioned as 18.05.1993 in the paper book whereas it is 01.01.1993 and prays that the same may be corrected.

Allowed as prayed for. The age of petitioner No.2 be read as

01.01.1993 instead of 18.05.1993.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 07.09.1995 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 01.01.1993. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh (Annexure P-6) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, the Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T., Chandigarh to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-6).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
