By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.824, dated 18.11.2014, registered under Section 135 of Indian Electricity (Supply) Act, at Police Station I & P, Rewari.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the electricity meter of the petitioner was out of order and no bill was issued by the complainant-DHBVNL. In pursuance of the order dated 24.12.2014, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has deposited the 50% of the amount of the bill in question.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, admits that the petitioner has deposited the compounding amount and has joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 24.12.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
