ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This order shall dispose of the aforementioned two petitions bearing CRM-M No. 44397 of 2014, titled as "Pardeep Versus State of Haryana" and CRM-M No. 5033 of 2015, titled as "Ravi Versus State of Haryana", as both these petitions seeking regular bail have arisen out of the same FIR bearing No. 95, dated 18.03.2014, registered under Sections 427 and 395 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station-Safidon.

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Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that all the private witnesses have failed to identify the petitioners and the trial will take long time to conclude and bail may be allowed.

The copies of the statements made by the private witnesses were shown during the course of the arguments. On the perusal of the statements, I find that four PWs examined by the prosecution, have failed to identify the petitioners.

The allegations in the FIR were that eight persons arrived on the petrol pump and broken the CCTV cameras and robbed the petrol pump and took ₹ 10,000/- and three mobile phones from the salesman.

The affidavit filed by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Safidon, District Jind, shows that there are several cases pending against the petitioners of similar nature registered between March and May 2014.

The trial will take long time to conclude. The above said petitions are allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
