Prayer in the present petition filed u/s 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 420, 468, 471, 120-B IPC and 13(1) P.C. Act, in a case arising out of FIR No. 4, dated 12.04.1997, registered at Police Station, State Vigilance Bureau, District-Hisar.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Banwari Lal, Police Station, State Vigilance Bureau, Hisar, very fairly states that in compliance of the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 13.01.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 13.01.2015, are made absolute.

However, petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
