The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case of snatching of the purse of the complainant Achal Rani containing cash and cell phone.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is delay of two months in lodging the FIR and name of the petitioner was involved at a later stage. He further submits that while purchasing the phone, he was involved in the case on the basis of recovery of cell phone from him.

On the asking of the Court, it has been informed by the State counsel that petitioner is not involved in any other case of similar nature.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and petitioner being in custody w.e.f. 05.12.2014, he can be granted concession of bail. Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
