The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari*, for quashing the notification dated 17.05.2004 (Annexure P-8), issued under Section 4 of the Land acquisition Act, 1894 (for short 'the Act'), followed by notification dated 21.03.2005 (Annexure P-10) issued under Section 6 of the Act, qua the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the State submitted that as per her instructions, the land of the petitioners has been released under Section 48 of the Act vide notification dated 06.07.2007. Learned counsel for the petitioners prayed that he may be allowed to withdraw the instant writ petition, but he is not able to get the notification dated 06.07.2007, therefore, liberty be granted to the petitioners to move an application for

revival of the writ petition, in case, the same is not correct.

3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the same.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to move an application for revival of the writ petition, in case something survives therein.
