Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking regular bail in FIR No.75 dated 16.11.2010, under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Heard.

As per the prosecution case, petitioner was found in possession of 210 grams of Diaphenoxylate. Although, petitioner was granted bail but during trial, he absented. Petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender and was later arrested.

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Subhash Chand has submitted that only two prosecution witnesses remained to be examined.

Keeping in view the above facts, no ground for grant of bail to the petitioner is made out.
