The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') seeking quashing of the FIR No.120 dated 5.9.2013 (Annexure P-1), registered for offence punishable under Sections 406/498-A IPC at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar, on the basis of the compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matrimonial dispute has since been amicably resolved and under the compromise (Annexure P-2), the petitioner and respondent No.2 are living together happily and amicably.

The parties had also appeared before the trial court and got their statements recorded wherein respondent No.2 has specifically stated that she had no objection if the impugned FIR is quashed. The trial court has sent its report dated 16.3.2015 stating therein that the compromise has been effected between the complainant and the accused which appears to be voluntary in nature and without any pressure or influence.

As the matter relates to matrimonial dispute which has been amicably resolved and the parties are living together it will be appropriate and in the interest of justice to quash the impugned FIR.

In view of the above discussion, the instant petition is allowed and the impugned FIR (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom is quashed.
