Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail stating that he has been summoned on the complaint of private respondent No. 2 under Section 3 (1) (iv) and (v) of Schedule Caste and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 (for short the Act) read with Section 427/34 of IPC. A perusal of complaint shows that the allegations are that five of accused including the present petitioner had cultivated the land occupied by the complainant. From the allegations itself, it is doubtful that Section 18 of the Act, will be attracted as such the anticipatory bail is allowed. Petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court. In the event of his arrest, he will be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of trial Court.

Application is accordingly allowed.
