Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.277 dated 02.12.2014 under Sections 147, 148, 323, 506, 354B IPC, registered at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that this very FIR has been quashed by this Court by a separate order passed today in CRM-M-383-2015 (Jai Parkash and anr. Vs. State of Haryana and anr.). He further submits that the petitioners have not misused the concession of interim protection granted by this Court vide order dated 08.01.2015. They have joined the investigation. He prays for allowing the present petition.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Satbir Singh, Police Station Khol, submits that in view of order dated 08.01.2015 passed in CRM-M-383-2015, parties have entered into a compromise and got their statements recorded before the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rewari in compliance of order passed by this Court.

In view of the above, order dated 08.01.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute subject to conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. Accordingly, present petition stands allowed.
