Petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail in a case registered at the instance of Ranjit Singh alleging that the petitioners connived with each other and others co-accused and trespassed the property of the complainant which had been got demarcated from the revenue authorities after intervention of the Court.

It is admitted that the complainant is in possession of the property. Petitioners have joined investigation. It does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation, so far as petitioners are concerned.

Petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioners, they will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
