By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.115, dated 05.11.2014, registered under Section 498-A IPC, at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner never raised any demand of dowry as alleged in the FIR and in pursuance of the order dated 31.12.2014, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that

the petitioner has raised a demand of Rs. 5 lacs. However, she admits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The petitioner is the mother in-law. Keeping in view the fact that petitioner has joined the investigation, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 31.12.2014, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
