The present petition has been filed by petitioner Meenu for giving direction to respondents no.2 to 4 for protection of her life and liberty at the hands of respondents no. 5 to 7.

As per the allegations in the petition, she was married at the age of 14 years with respondent no. 7 Mohit Yadav. She was not satisfied with the said marriage as she was too young. She was tortured physically and mentally by her in-laws. Her husband is a drug addict. Respondents no. 5 to 7 have made her life miserable and she does not want

to keep any relationship with them. She is living alone for the last seven months. Respondents no. 5 to 7 are pressurizing her by using all unlawful means. Her father-respondent no. 6 has lodged a false complaint of kidnapping in Police Station Kosli, Tehsil Kosli, District Rewari against one Yogesh Kumar son of Ram Chander resident of village Jholri, Tehsil Kosli, District Rewari. Hence this petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner pleaded that the petitioner has moved a representation (Annexure P-4) to the Superintendent of Police, Rewari for providing the protection, but no action has been taken upon that representation. Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner will be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Rewari to consider her representation (Annexure P-4) to provide the police help.

In view of the aforesaid contentions raised by learned counsel for the petitioner, the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Rewari to consider the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-4) dated 26.12.2014 for the purpose of satisfying himself whether there is any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners and then to take the appropriate action as per law for providing the police protection to the

petitioner.

A copy of this order be communicated to the Superintendent of Police, Rewari along with copy of Annexure P-4 through ASI Mangtu Ram, Police Station Kosli, District Rewari for compliance.

A copy of this order be also supplied to the petitioner under the signatures of the Special Secretary as per rules.
