Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and have performed marriage on 26.12.2014 at Panchkula. They have threat perception at the hands of private respondents and precisely for that grievance a representation dated 27.12.2014 (Annexure P-6) is statedly pending before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar.

Let notice of motion be issued to respondents No.1 to 3.

At this stage, Mr. P.S.Ghuman, Additional Advocate

General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

A copy of the petition be given to Mr.P.S.Ghuman, Additional Advocate General, Punjab during the course of the day.

In view of nature of allegations and claim put forth by the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with a direction to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to look into the allegations made by the petitioners and take appropriate action if required, in the context of providing necessary protection, in accordance with law.
