The petitioner in the present petition has challenged the interim orders dated 04.06.2014 and 21.07.2014 (**Annexures P-10 and P-11 respectively**), passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Chandigarh, during the trial in case FIR No.49 dated 21.03.2012, under Sections 419, 420, 511 and 177 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Sector 3, Chandigarh.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused submits that the present petition has become infructuous since the main FIR and all subsequent proceedings have already been quashed on the basis of the compromise.
