The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.38 dated 21.03.2014 registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 of the IPC and Sections 308 and 325 of the IPC added later at Police Station Civil Line, Batala, Distt. Batala.

Vide order dated 13.02.2015, petitioner was directed to appear before the trial Court within ten days and on doing so, it was directed that the trial Court shall release him on interim bail to its satisfaction.

In compliance of the above-said order the petitioner appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, on 23.02.2015

and submitted bail bonds which were accepted by the learned Magistrate.

A certified copy of the order dated 23.02.2015 is being taken on record in the aforesaid context.

In view of the aforesaid the interim bail granted to the petitioner on 13.02.2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
