NAVITA SINGH, J. (ORAL)

State counsel submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the complainant, however, submits that petitioner No. 2 could not be granted anticipatory bail, as he inflicted serious injuries on the person of the injured.

FIR, however, shows that petitioner No. 2 – Fazar had inflicted blow on the left hand of Sahid which is not a vital part of the body.

Interim relief of bail granted to co-accused Mubarak and others was made absolute vide order dated 09.01.2015.

The present FIR was registered after a case had been got registered by the accused persons herein by way of FIR No. 427 in the same police station.

In view of the above, interim relief granted to the petitioners is made absolute.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
