The instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No. 38 dated 17.5.2009 registered under Sections 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Verowal, District Tarn Taran.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that they had appeared before the learned trial Court. After appearance, they were charge sheeted and the evidence of the prosecution had been recorded. Since they have been acquitted by the trial Court against the charges levelled against them, the present petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
