Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of impugned FIR No.5 dated 23.1.2014 registered under Sections, 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala as well as subsequent criminal proceedings arising therefrom.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurjeet Singh, Police Station Women Cell, Patiala, submits that after conducting an effective investigation, cancellation report was prepared. Thereafter on the request made by the complainant, further investigation was ordered by Special Investigating Team, constituted by the competent authority. Even the Special Investigating Team, after further investigation, has reiterated earlier conclusion arrived at by the investigating agency and prepared the cancellation report, which shall be presented to the learned court of competent jurisdiction, at an early date. She further submits that in view of the cancellation report having been prepared, the present petition does not survive and may be disposed of, as such.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner also fairly states that let the instant petition be disposed of, in view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the State.
