The present petition is directed against the order dated 2.8.2014 (Annexure P-3) issued by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ludhiana, whereby non-bailable warrants were issued against the petitioner as he did not appear before the learned trial Court on the date fixed in the criminal trial arising out of FIR No.88 dated 12.6.2013 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Gurdeep Singh, Police Station Sadar Ludhiana and also referring to short reply filed, submits that since in compliance of the order dated 11.2.2015 passed by this Court, petitioner has appeared before the learned trial Court and furnished his bail bonds which have been accepted by the learned trial Court vide order dated 3.3.2015, no further orders are warranted.

In view of the above and without commenting anything further on merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 11.5.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute.

Disposed of, accordingly.
