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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner and other family members are being summoned to the police station on the complaint of respondent No. 4, who happens to be the wife of his deceased brother Kuldip Singh. The only prayer is that the police should comply with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C., while summoning the petitioner and other family members as it is claimed that they are being repeatedly called to the police station.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Station House Office, Police Station 'B' Division, District Amritsar City, to comply with the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C., if the petitioner and other family members are to be summoned to the police station.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
