Report dated 19.3.2015 of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received after recording statements of accused Rahul Kalra as well as complainant Disha and the learned court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise is an outcome of voluntariness, free will and without any coercion or undue pressure. A demand draft bearing No. 318467 dated 1.5.2015 for Rs 5 lacs drawn on Indian Overseas Bank, Amritsar has been handed over by petitioner Rahul Kalra to complainant/respondent no. 2-Disha today in the Court. Photostat copy of the same has been placed on record. In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court and in view of the fact that it is a pure matrimonial dispute and

compromise will go a long way in ironing out the differences and for betterment of their future life and in view of which the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 356 dated 2.10.2014 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar under sections 406,498-A IPC and all consequences arising thereof are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
