Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.193 dated 17.12.2014, under Sections 420, 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bhatinda.

Heard.

As per prosecution case, petitioner had demanded ₹4,50,000/- from the complainant for providing job in the Forest Department. Complainant paid ₹1,55,000/- to the petitioner. However, petitioner was neither provided the job to the complainant nor the amount paid was returned to him.

Keeping in view the seriousness of allegations, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made out. Before the Sessions Court, petitioner was granted interim bail, but the recovery of the amount in question could not be effected and therefore, bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed by the Sessions Court. Petitioner might be required for custodial interrogation.
