SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C.') has been filed by the petitioners seeking quashing of First Information Report No.13 dated 30.5.2010 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 324, 447, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the ground of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

In pursuance of the order dated 12.2.2015 passed by this Court, learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Fatehgarh Sahib has sent her report with regard to the genuineness of the compromise Annexure P-1. In her report, she has stated that the statements of parties have been recorded. None of the accused is proclaimed offender. The compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue

influence. Copies of the statements of the parties are attached with the report.

Respondent No.2- complainant is present. He has produced copy of his driving licence, which is taken on record.

In view of the above, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose would be served in continuing the proceedings. In view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others, (2012)10 SCC 303**, the Court is competent to quash the proceedings on the basis of compromise. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and First Information Report No.13 dated 30.5.2010(Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 324, 447, 34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
