Violation of statutory rights has been claimed as a ground for grant of bail. The said grounds may constitute sufficient reasons for acquittal but in view of Section 37 of the NDPS Act applicable in case of recovery of commercial quantity of 100 grams intoxicating powder containing diphenoxycate hydrochloride, I do not find any ground to grant the concession of bail to petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
