These are two petitions filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure praying for pre arrest release of the petitioners in a case FIR No.327 dated 07.11.2014, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326 and 506 IPC registered at Police Station Chandhut, District Palwal, Haryana (in CRM-M-4652-2015) and in a case FIR No.293 dated 03.10.2014 under Sections 323, 307 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Chandhut, District Palwal, Haryana (in CRM-M-4657-2015).

It was stated before this Court that dispute has erupted between real brothers and close relatives and matter has since been resolved amicably. Certain misc. applications have been filed for quashing of the FIR which are stated to be pending before this Court.

The aforesaid fact has not been disputed by the learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from HC Suresh Kumar.

Be that as it may, it would be futile to subject the petitioners to process of arrest etc. particularly when the dispute has erupted between the family members and has been resolved.

Consequently, the petitions are accepted and the interim directions issued vide orders dated 12.02.2015 and 24.02.2015 are hereby made absolute leaving the parties to the remedies in law under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure which concededly they have resorted to.
