This petition has been moved by Paramvir Singh alias Phana under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking his regular bail in case FIR No.111 dated 13.11.2013 registered under Sections 302, 201, 376, 176, 34 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Barnal, District Barnala.

It was ordered on the last date that on 19.2.2015, the State shall ensure the presence of the complainant and Makhan Singh witness and the examination of both the witnesses would be completed by the trial Court on that date.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Tek Chand, Police Station Barnala submits that the complainant had moved an application for giving up PW Makhan Singh but he was not sure whether he was given up or not.

Counsel for the petitioner, however, states at the bar that Makhan Singh was given up while the statement of the complainant was completed as directed by this Court.

The material witnesses have already been examined and, therefore, there is no likelihood of tampering with the evidence and dealing with witnesses by the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
