This is the fourth application for grant of regular bail.

The petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 11.10.2013 in a case registered at the instance of Anoop Kumar alleging that petitioner along with other co-accused armed with iron rods had trespassed into the house of the complainant and assaulted his family members. The material eye witnesses and injured witnesses have already been examined. Their statements have been placed on record as Annexure P-2. The witnesses have turned hostile.

In view of matter having been compromised, a petition for compromise is also stated to have been filed.

Taking into consideration the statements of the witnesses brought on record, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
