INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.183 dated 15.11.2014, registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. Neither he has signed the alleged agreement to sell nor he is the beneficiary to the said agreement to sell. The allegation against the petitioner is that he is the attesting witness of the power of attorney as well as the sale deed. The case is based on documentary evidence. The petitioner has already joined the

investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose will be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is accepted and the order dated 12.02.2015, passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
