FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a supplementary application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.120 dated 12.12.2014 under Sections 326,341,506,148,149 IPC and Section 307 IPC (added later) registered at Police Station City Gidder Baha, District Mukatsar.

The allegations against the petitioner in this supplementary bail application are that on 11.12.2014 petitioner armed with handle of spade along with his co-accused brother Manish Kumar, who armed with knife assaulted the injured-complainant Gobind Ram. It is contended on behalf of the petitioner that injury on the face of the complainant is attributed to the petitioner which is opined to be simple in nature and that

the injury on the tooth of the complainant which has resulted in breaking of tooth is attributed to the non-applicant/co-accused Manish Kumar regarding which offence under Section 307 has been added later could not be controverted on behalf of the State and the learned State counsel further conceded that there is no medical evidence to corroborate the averment that the injury on the person of the injured was dangerous to life and admits that in pursuance of interim bail petitioner has joined investigations.

Keeping in view the same, the present application for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
