As per allegations of the prosecution, on 29.05.2014, the petitioner was found sitting on the bags containing 50 kgs of poppy husk. The quantity recovered is non-commercial in nature.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Baljinder Singh, has stated at the bar that challan has not been presented till date.

In view of the above circumstances, the petitioner is entitled to concession of regular bail on merits as well as by invoking the provisions of Section 167 (2) Cr.P.C as the challan has not been presented till date.

So, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition stands allowed. The petitioner Ravinder Singh @ Bhallu is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial court.
