The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.183 dated 05.12.2014, under Sections 406, 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, P.S. City Hoshiarpur.

Prayer for anticipatory bail has been opposed by the complainant on the ground that in pursuance to agreement to sell an

amount of Rs.60 lacs was paid as earnest money on 03.03.2014 and target date was fixed as 03.03.2015. Later on it was transpired that Narinder Kaur, Sarpanch/accused No.1, who was on visiting terms with the complainant has cheated the complainant in connivance with her father Munsha Ram and petitioner who was also attesting witness to the agreement along with Narinder Kaur. Munsha Ram projected himself to be Nasib Chand and all were instrumental in receiving huge amount of Rs.60 lacs.

Complainant has prima facie shown source of receiving Rs.60 lacs by putting land to sale in favour of Rajinder Singh who has made available the amount in question to them.

Investigation is in progress. No ground for grant of anticipatory is made out.

Petition stands dismissed.
