SABINA, J.

Petitioner has filed petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of order dated 04.11.2014 (Annexure P-5).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that with a view to settle the dispute, petitioner had handed over drafts/cheques of the amount in question to the respondent. However, respondent had not encashed the same. Due to this reason, petitioner could not appear before the trial Court as he was under the impression that the matter had been compromised. However, petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and face the trial.

Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in case petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within fifteen days from today, he be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
