Learned counsel for the State points out that the prayer in the present petition is for issuing of directions to the official respondent Nos.1 and 2 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioner from respondent No.5 and to take legal action against the official respondent Nos. 3 and 4. He on

instructions from ASI Gurtej Singh of Police Station Sadar Mansa, further submits that during the pendency of the present petition, FIR No.4 dated 11.01.2014, for the offence punishable under Section 420 IPC was registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa and after thorough investigation, the cancellation report was presented. After issuing notice to the informant, the said cancellation report was accepted by learned Area Judicial Magistrate and as such, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
