Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since during the pendency of the present revision petition, parties have arrived at an amicable settlement, present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of, as such.

Learned counsel for the respondent also submits that he has got no objection regarding the disposal of the present petition. The amount of Rs.15,000/- which was deposited by the petitioner towards litigation expenses, as per the orders passed by this Court on 24.04.2012, may be directed to be released in favour of the respondent.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous. However, office is directed to release the amount of Rs.15,000/- in favour of the respondent namely Smt. Anita wife of Sh. Jitender, against a proper receipt towards her litigation expenses, which was deposited by the petitioner in compliance of the order dated 24.04.2012 passed by this Court.
