By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.2, dated 08.01.2015, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Sekhwan, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The learned counsel contends that the petitioner who is employed as Marketing Developer Coordinator with Amritsar Cold Drinks, was not at home at the time of occurrence. The other members of the family were also away to attend some bhog ceremony. He had a happy married life. The deceased was all alone at the time of incident.

The petitioner being present at the time of occurrence

will be seen by the trial Court. At this stage, the petitioner cannot claim any relief on account plea of of alibi. The death of a young woman has taken place in the matrimonial home, therefore, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail sought at this stage.

Dismissed.
