RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance to order dated 13.02.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Kler, Advocate, counsel for the complainant, states that the petitioner has not facilitated recovery of gold ornaments. Marriage was solemnized

Looking to the entire facts and circumstances of the case, interim order dated 13.02.2015 is made absolute.
