Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Section 498-A IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No. 45, dated 13.04.2014, registered at Police Station, Division No.2, District Pathankot.

This Court vide order dated 26.03.2015 has granted ad-interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining of investigation and to comply with the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2). Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 26.03.2015, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Harpreet Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order dated 26.03.2015 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

However, petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
