Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.3 dated 19.07.2012 under Sections 409, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 (1) (d) read with Section 13 (2), 88 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, District Ferozepur.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.
