AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for the grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.77 dated 29.10.2014, under Sections 406, 420 IPC, reregistered at Police station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

The complainant is present as identified by the investigating officer namely SI Kamaljeet. He has accepted the proposal made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the last date. He further states that if the petitioner pays the remaining amount of Rs. 3.5 lacs by 31.03.2015 he would also have no objection in getting this FIR quashed on the basis of compromise.

In these circumstances I see no reason to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. In the event of his arrest, let him be

released on bail to the satisfaction of the investigating officer subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
