Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks appropriate directions against the respondent authorities for protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

Status report was sought which was filed by way of an affidavit dated 29.4.2015.

Learned counsel for the State submits that after conducting an effective investigation by Superintendent of Police (Detective), Amritsar (Rural), cancellation report has been prepared which is pending approval of the competent authority. She further submits that in view of the preparation of the cancellation report, present petition has been rendered infructuous, because the petitioner would receive a notice before the cancellation report is accepted by the learned court of competent jurisdiction. Petitioner would be at liberty to file his protest petition to the cancellation report and pursue his remedy, in accordance with law.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner also fairly states that let the instant petition may be disposed of, in view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the State with liberty to the petitioner to pursue his remedy, in accordance with law.

In view of the above-said statements made by the learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of, with liberty as prayed for.
