SNEH PRASHAR, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.125 dated 11.07.2007, under Sections 460, 342 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the co-accused namely Haman Kumar @ Tita and Ankush Singla have already been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 02.02.2015 passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-36106 of 2014 titled as Haman Kumar @ Tita and another Vs. State of Punjab.

Learned counsel further submits that though petitioners were prima-facie named in the First Information Report but subsequently in the final report filed under Section 173 Cr.P.C., the petitioners were found to be not connected with the crime.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that the co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

It is a case of dual version. The role attributed to the petitioners is identical to the allegation against the co-accused who have already been allowed anticipatory bail. Also nothing is stated to be recovered from the petitioners. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest of the petitioners they shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/ Investigating Officer. They shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
