This petition is for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise. FIR No. 38 of 21.04.2008 under Sections 323/326/382/452/201 read with Section 34 IPC was registered on the statement of present respondent No. 2. Both the private respondents were injured persons.

The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender as he absconded and went to Italy.

On verification of record, counsel for the petitioner informed that the petitioner had left India much after the present case was registered against him which was early in 2008 and he left in 2009.

The intention of the petitioner was clearly to abscond so that he may not be arrested in the present case.

Now the matter is stated to have already been compromised with the co-accused and that is why he made a compromise with the complainant and filed the petition.

The petitioner has again resorted to total abuse of the process of Court.

Dismissed.
