By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.92, dated 29.11.2014, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, District Gurdaspur.

It is contended that the petitioner is not a travel agent and she has been falsely implicated in the instant case. In fact, no transaction ever took place between the petitioner and the complainant. The learned counsel refers to the enquiry report dated 26.11.2013 (Annexure P-1) and states that the son of the complainant has returned back from Bahrain of his own.

Perusal of the record would reveal that the petitioner had made a statement before the trial Court that she shall repay Rs. 60,000/- to the complainant. The statement made by the petitioner was not honoured. In the circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant the concession of bail sought at this stage.

Dismissed.
